

Tech company Delaget moves to bigger HQ and plans more hiring

Restaurant-software company **Delaget** has moved into larger digs to accommodate its growing staff.

The company relocated from Eden Prairie to 15,000 square feet at 5320 West 23rd St. in St. Louis Park. The space is about 60 percent larger than Delaget's previous offices.

Delaget has about 89 employees, including 59 in Minnesota (the rest are in Nixa, Mo.), a company spokesman said. That's up from about 30 workers in 2013.

Delaget expects to double its workforce over the next three years.

"We've been growing like crazy with new customers and new team members," Delaget CEO **Jason Tober** said in a **prepared statement**. "It's an exciting time to join Delaget. When you're passionate about helping customers, you need to attract and retain the very best people, and we believe our new office space will help us do that by reflecting our culture of innovation, hustle and fun."

A former Jamf Software and Shavlik Technologies executive, Tober joined Delaget as CEO last year **as the company raised an undisclosed amount of funding** from Wayzata-based growth equity firm Northern Pacific Group.

Delaget makes analytics and financial-reporting software for restaurants. The company's clients include North Carolina-based Biscuitville, Jiffy Lube franchises and Wendy's.
